# Doris Saunders Community Scholarship 2023 - 2024 Academic Year

Calling all College Bound Students - The Birchwood/Clearview Manor Community Association (BCCA) in collaboration with our residents want to celebrate passionate, college-bound students, as you prepare to take the next step on your journey to greatness! We are looking for dedicated students. We are looking for leaders... We are looking for students that have given back to their community. A leader in school! The bottom line is that we want to reward students who have excelled both in and outside of the classroom. If this sounds like you, please keep reading!

The *Doris Saunders Scholarship*, in the amount of \$400.00, is in honor and loving memory of a valued, beloved community member and volunteer who served her community. We want to continue in the tradition of paying it forward and honor students who have given back to the community and will continue to "give back" to their community. Two deserving students will receive the scholarship, based on merit, leadership and commitment to community.

#### **Qualifications to Apply:**

- 1) Graduated from high school in May/June 2023;
- 2) is a current Birchwood/Clearview Manor resident;
- 3) is planning to enroll in an accredited undergraduate program for the 2023 2024 Academic school year; and,
- 4) Must have a grade point average of 2.75 Proof of all qualifications will be required, if selected.

The **Doris Saunders Scholarship** recipients will be selected by a committee, based on the following:

- Participation and leadership in the community (including church and/or place of worship) and high school leadership activities (list your activities in your submission); and
- 2) Submission of a 200-word essay: "Why higher education and community involvement are important in the 21st Century."

Applicants should submit their entries to the 2023 BCCA Scholarship Committee, no later than **August 5, 2023**. **Please include your address, phone number, e-mail and Parent/Guardian contact information**. The scholarship proceeds will be paid directly to your institution to assist with books or tuition. If you are selected, you will be notified by e-mail and will be honored at a future Birchwood/Clearview Manor Community meeting. And, your essay will be shared in the BCCA Newsletter.

#### What's New

**BCCA Announcement Board (entrance of Crisfield Court)** - Did you see the improved BCCA Announcement board when you turn on to Crisfield Drive and Livingston Road and the BCCA Meeting announcement signs? Thank you so much Vice President Elton Jones! More to come.

**New Elderly Property Tax Credit!** This new credit, effective July 1, 2023, will provide up to a 20% credit of the County property taxes, inclusive of any Homeowners and Homestead Tax Credit, for up to 5 years. Applications will be made available in Spring 2023. To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Age 65 and over;
- 2. Own and reside at property for which credit is sought for at least the previous 10 years;
- 3. The assessed value does not exceed \$500,000 at the time of application;
- 4. The application must be submitted by October 1, 2023.

The application gives an email address in which you may submit your completed form. You may even submit a picture copy of the completed application and attach it in your email, if you do not have a scanner. Click on link below to print the application/FAQs:

#### **Dogs Should Be On Leash**

Per Prince George's County Regulations, it is against the law for the owner or custodian of any animal to allow the animal to run atlarge. See Prince George's Code of Ordinances: Division 4:

Animal Control, Subdivision 1-Enforcement and Violation Notices, Section 3-135(a) (f), which requires that all dogs be kept on a leash at all times unless they are on the owners' private property, and even then, the owners much have control over them. Violators are subject to pet impoundment and fines. Call 311 with concerns.

#### **No Smoking in Parks**

The Department of Parks and Recreation in Prince George's County, part of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, sends a reminder to the community that its parks have been and will continue to be smoke free. This includes all forms of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes and marijuana.
