TRANSPORTATION FOR SENIORS IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

Nutrition Program: Senior County residents may receive free transportation to strategically located group sites for a nutritional lunch and companionship. Senior residents who are homebound, and cannot attend a nutrition site, may be eligible to have meals delivered to their residence.

Medical Program: County seniors and residents with disabilities may receive transportation throughout the County for medical purposes, especially dialysis.

General Transportation: Limited transportation is provided for County seniors to visit senior activity centers, for shopping trips, and other recreational purposes. Doris Saunders Community Scholarship 2023 - 2024 Academic Year Due Date Extended

Calling all College Bound Students - The Birchwood/Clearview Manor Community Association (BCCA) in collaboration with our residents want to celebrate passionate, college-bound students, as you prepare to take the next step on your journey to greatness! We are looking for dedicated students, leaders, students that have given back to their community or a leader in school! The bottom line is that we want to reward students who have excelled both in and outside of the classroom. If this sounds like you, please keep reading!

The *Doris Saunders Scholarship*, in the amount of \$400.00, is in honor and loving memory of a valued, beloved community member and volunteer who served her community. We want to continue in the tradition of paying it forward and honor students who have given back to the community and will continue to "give back" to their community. Two deserving students will receive the scholarship, based on merit, leadership and commitment to community.

Qualifications to Apply:

- 1) Graduated from high school in May/June 2023;
- 2) is a current Birchwood/Clearview Manor resident:
- 3) is planning to enroll in an accredited undergraduate program for the 2023 2024 Academic school year; and,
- 4) Must have a grade point average of 2.75 Proof of all qualifications will be required, if selected.

The **Doris Saunders Scholarship** recipients will be selected by a committee, based on the following:

- Participation and leadership in the community (including church and/or place of worship) and high school leadership activities (list your activities in your submission); and
- 2) Submission of a 200-word essay: "Why higher education and community involvement are important in the 21st Century."

Applicants' submission date August 5, 2023, has been extended. Entries should be submitted to the 2023 BCCA Scholarship Committee, no later than August 31, 2023. Please include your address, phone number, e-mail and Parent/Guardian contact information. The scholarship proceeds will be paid directly to your institution to assist with books or tuition. If you are selected, you will be notified by e-mail and will be honored at a future Birchwood/Clearview Manor Community meeting. And, your essay will be shared in the BCCA Newsletter.

BCCA's New Email for 311 Reports, Suggestions and Concerns – BCCA has initiated a new email address bccaconcerns@gmail.com for neighbors to solicited their suggestions and/or concerns to BCCA at any time, not just in our monthly meeting. Also, BCCA Vice President, Elton Jones, is keeping track of the Prince George's County 311 Reports. Therefore, after you have submitted a 311 Report (with picture(s), if possible) and receive a report number, please submit your 311 Report number and picture(s) to the email above. BCCA will do what it can to address your concerns and/or suggestions. Thank you!

New Elderly Property Tax Credit Application? This new credit, effective July 1, 2023, will provide up to a 20% credit of the County property taxes, inclusive of any Homeowners and Homestead Tax Credit, for up to 5 years. Applications will be made available in Spring 2023. To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Age 65 and over;
- 2. Own and reside at property for which credit is sought for at least the previous 10 years;
- 3. The assessed value does not exceed \$500,000 at the time of application;
- 4. The application must be submitted by October 1, 2023.
