FIRE PREVENTION CODE ... - eLaws It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, possess, store, offer for sale, expose for sale, sell, discharge, use, burn, or explode any fireworks in Prince George's County, Maryland, except that an authorized display may be conducted by a fireworks shooter.

Dogs Should Be On Leash - Per Prince George's County Regulations, it is against the law for the owner or custodian of any animal to allow the

animal to run at-large. Violators are subject to pet impoundment and fines. Call 311 with concerns.

<u>No Smoking in Parks</u> - The Department of Parks and Recreation in Prince George's County, part of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, sends a reminder to the community that its parks have been and will continue to be smoke free. This includes all forms of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes and marijuana.

FYI - Beginning the week of July 1, 2024, Prince George's County is expanding its <u>*Clear the Curb*</u> waste collection services for residents receiving County-contracted trash and recycling pickup. The new services will increase the number of acceptable curbside bulky trash items **from two (2) to four (4)** and introduce monthly curbside scrap metal and electronics recycling appointments. These enhanced services will continue modernizing and streamlining our current residential collection services.
