The **Doris Saunders Scholarship**, in the amount of \$400.00, is in honor and loving memory of a valued, beloved community member and volunteer who served her community. Qualifications to Apply:

4) Must have a grade point average of 2.75

Proof of all qualifications will be required, if selected.

- 1) Participation and leadership in the community (including church and/or place of worship) and high school leadership activities (list your activities in your submission); and
- 2) Submission of a 200-word essay: "Why higher education and community involvement are important in the 21st Century."

Update: Playground Installation

Although bids had been sent out for this project, I was advised earlier this week of the following.

- a. Original Bids are obsolete,
- b. Close Bids will be going out soon which are mandated by the new budget,
- c. Our original monies earmark for this project are safe, and

d. Additional monies are required to build the correct drainage to ensure the surface of the play area is habitable at all times.

(Approximate cost \$ 140,000.00). MNCPPC internal Finance Department has been advised of the additional cost needed to complete this project.) Estimate groundbreaking will be during the First Quarter of 2025.

Dogs Should Be On Leash - Per Prince George's County Regulations, it is against the law for the owner or custodian of any animal to allow the animal to run at-large. Violators are subject to pet impoundment and fines. Call 311 with concerns.

<u>No Smoking in Parks</u> - The Department of Parks and Recreation in Prince George's County, part of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, sends a reminder to the community **that its parks** have been and will continue to be smoke free. This includes all forms of tobacco, e-cigarettes, vapes and marijuana.

FYI - Beginning the week of July 1, 2024, Prince George's County is expanding its <u>Clear the Curb</u> waste collection services for residents receiving County-contracted trash and recycling pickup. The new services will increase the number of acceptable curbside bulky trash items from two (2) to four (4) and introduce monthly curbside scrap metal and electronics recycling appointments. These enhanced services will continue modernizing and streamlining our current residential collection services.

Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) will offer free summer meal service at 25 school sites for youth under age 18 now through Friday, August 9. Breakfast will be served from 9:00 AM to 9:30 AM and lunch from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM. Meals must be eaten on site, and dates and times are subject to change.
