
Community-Wide Meeting will be held in-person on Thursday,

It is important more than ever; it is crucial for Birchwood's Hispanic/Latino individuals to actively engage with the Birchwood City-Clearview Community Association to step up into leadership or volunteer roles to help shape the future of our Birchwood community.

Here is why-and how-it can make a difference for us all:


