

As declared from the White House and state and local governments, November is the **National Family Caregivers Month.** It is a monthlong observance that aims to:

- Honor the work of family caregivers.
- Raise awareness of the challenges caregivers face.
- Provide resources and support to caregivers.
- Encourage involvement of communities.
- Promote the wellbeing of caregivers.
- Advocate for caregiver-friendly policies.

As stated in the White House's **Proclamation on National Family Caregivers Month 2024**, "Family caregivers are the backbone of our Nation, making tremendous sacrifices to be there for the people who need and cherish them most."

In an October 2024 Bulletin, Maryland Department of Aging announced the receipt of a \$490,000 grant to support family caregivers, specifically to increase outreach, advance partnerships, and strengthen services and support for family caregivers. The Bulletin noted that according to AARP, in 2023, there were an estimated 760,000 unpaid caregivers in MD. 
